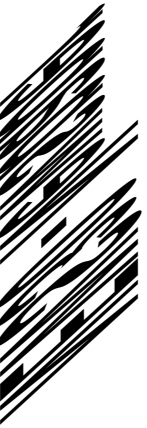
Purpose: Foundation Studies is a multi-disciplinary series of courses designed to provide all high school students at Belleville Mennonite School with an opportunity to
